Alaska

Anchorage is Alaska's largest city, but you still sense the proximity of the wilderness and the frontier spirit. Among the sights: the world's largest seaplane base, and the Museum of History and Art. Witness the tidal bore along Turnagain Arm (conditions permitting), when a wall of water up to six feet high rushes up the inlet.

Homer, on the Kenai Peninsula, attracts fishermen, artists and seekers of spectacular scenery. Across the bay a timbered coastline rises to the glacier-capped peaks of the Kenai Mountains. Visit Homer Spit, a bustle with fisherfolk, a small-boat harbor, canneries, boat building shops and the occasional artist with an easel.

Denali National Park and Preserve is home to North America's tallest mountain, and to wildlife in amazing abundance. Weather permitting, you may catch a glimpse of 20,320-ft. Mt. McKinley long before you reach the park, from the highway between Anchorage and Fairbanks. To fully enjoy your time in the area, sign up for an optional tour, like the Denali Jeep® Backcountry Safari.

Fairbanks began as a Gold Rush town and has been thriving ever since. Here you may inspect the TransAlaska Pipeline, just outside of town. Pay a visit to Gold Dredge #8, and try your hand at panning.

Skagway was one of the liveliest towns in the hemisphere in 1898, when it was the gateway to Gold Rush Country. And it hasn't lost a particle of its spirit.

The whole down-town is a National Historic Park, with its well-trodden boardwalks and false-fronted saloons. Shopping is fun here, for anything from gold nugget jewelry to original works of Alaskan art.

The Alaska Highway

This historic road began as a one-lane supply line to Alaska at the outbreak of World War II. Today it runs from Dawson Creek, BC, for 1,520 miles to Fairbanks. Along the way you might spot moose, caribou, bison and Dall sheep.

Kluane National Park and Preserve, between Whitehorse and Beaver Creek, is an UNESCO World Heritage Site. It contains some of Canada's highest peaks and is a prime wildlife-viewing area. The Alaska Highway skirts crystal-clear, glacier-fed Kluane Lake for 40 miles while the snow clad, 7,000-ft.-plus Kluane Ranges parallel the highway to the west. Take side trips into the park for trout fishing, gold panning, walking the tundra and marveling at colorful wildflowers. The scenery is incredible. You may glimpse distant giants of the St. Elias Mountain Range.

The Yukon

Whitehorse, capital of Yukon Territory, is a friendly modern city that provides vivid reminders of its Gold Rush beginnings. Here, on the banks of the Yukon River, the prospectors who struggled up from Skagway had their first chance to dry out after running the treacherous rapids of the Yukon River. You may visit the grand old sternwheeler, S.S. Klondike, permanently anchored on dry land by the riverside. Take the whole family for an evening of hilarious history at the Frantic Follies Vaudeville Revue.

Dawson City is a perfectly preserved Gold Rush town. Hardly anything has changed since the boom days when thousands descended on the town to get rich quick.

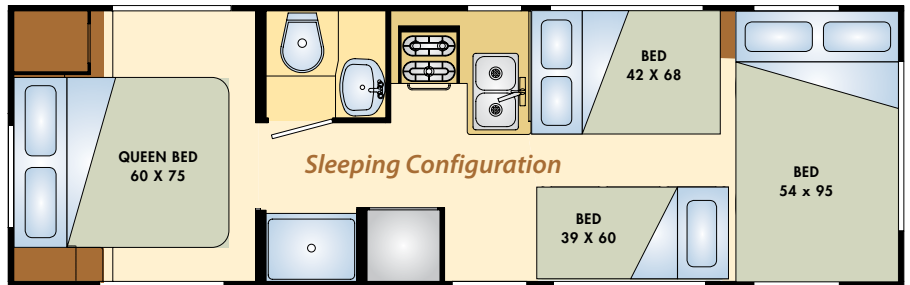
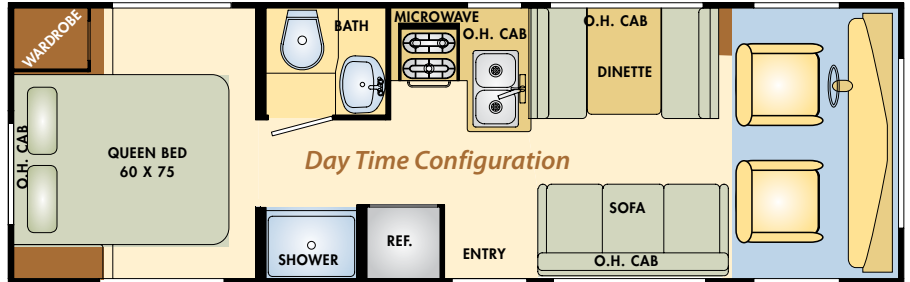

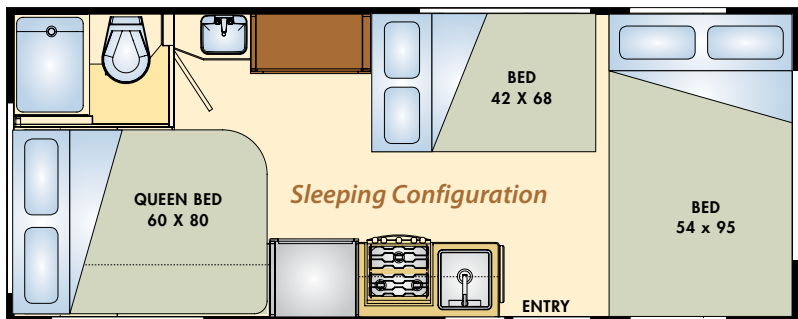
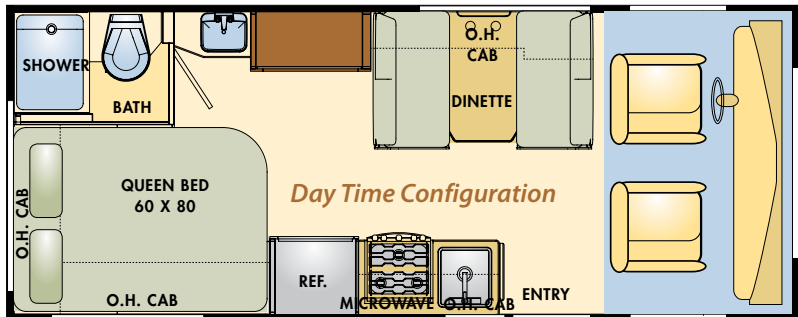
Large RV

2012 RENTAL TERMS & SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

RENTAL SIZES. Standard size motorhomes are 21 to 24-feet in length. Large size motorhomes are 28 to 31-feet in length.

ANCHORAGE SUNDAY SAVINGS. For rentals either picked up and dropped off in Anchorage on a Sunday, deduct \$2.00 per day from the rate table above. For rentals that are both picked up and dropped off in Anchorage on a Sunday deduct \$4.00 per day.

SKAGWAY SATURDAY SAVINGS. For rentals either picked up and dropped off in Skagway on a Saturday, deduct \$2.00 per day from the rate table above. For rentals that are both picked up and dropped off in Skagway on a Saturday deduct \$4.00 per day.

MILEAGE CHARGES. If the unlimited mileage option is not purchased mileage is charged at the rate of \$.25 per mile.

UNLIMITED MILEAGE OPTION. Add \$35.00 per day to the rate tables above.

ANCHORAGE VEHICLE RENTAL TAX. Municipality of Anchorage vehicle rental tax of 8% applies to all rentals originating in Anchorage. Tax applies to rental rates and mileage charges as well as one-way drop fees, if applicable, up to a maximum of \$240.00 per consecutive rental period.

ALASKA VEHICLE RENTAL TAX. State of Alaska RV rental tax of 3% applies to all rentals originating in Alaska. The tax applies to rental rates and mileage charges.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF LOCATIONS. Anchorage, Alaska; Fairbanks, Alaska; Skagway, Alaska and Seattle, Washington.

DEPOSITS AND FINAL PAYMENTS. A deposit of \$450 per RV is due within 10 days from date of reservation confirmation. Final payment is due 30 days prior to date of RV pick up for round trip rentals and 60 days prior to date of RV pick up for one-way rentals.

HOUSEKEEPING PACKAGE. "Housekeeping Package" is \$35 per person, per rental, and includes bedding (sheets, pillowcases, blankets, pillows) towels, eating, cooking, and storage ware.

INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLE, COLLISION DAMAGE WAIVER (CDW) AND DAMAGE DEPOSIT. Insurance deductible without CDW is \$1,500. Deductible with CDW is \$250. Optional CDW is \$19 per day. Damage deposit with CDW is \$250. Damage deposit without CDW is \$500.

CANCELLATION FEES. The following cancellation fees apply for motorhomes picked up and dropped off at the same location:

- If canceled after reservation is confirmed by deposit, but 61 or more days prior to first day of rental – Full refund less \$50 processing fee and loss of Cancellation Fees Protection payment if applicable.

- If canceled between 31 and 60 days prior to first day of rental - \$250
- If canceled between 16 and 30 days prior to first day of rental - \$350

- If canceled 15 or fewer days prior to first day of rental – No refund

The following cancellation fees apply for one-way motorhome rentals:

- If canceled after reservation is confirmed by deposit, but 91 or more days prior to first day of rental – Full refund less \$50 processing fee and loss of Cancellation Fees Protection payment if applicable.

- If canceled between 61 and 90 days prior to first day of rental - \$250

- If canceled between 46 and 60 days prior to first day of rental - \$350

- If canceled 45 or fewer days prior to first day of rental – No refund

WINDSHIELD DAMAGE PROTECTION. Optional windshield damage coverage is available for purchase at \$10 per day of rental. This coverage will protect customers for charges pertaining to and requiring windshield damage repair or replacement not associated with a collision, rollover, and acts of negligence or reckless driving.

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS. Drivers must be a minimum of 25 years of age and be in possession of valid drivers license that does not expire during the period of the rental. Drivers are required to complete and sign the company's Rental Agreement.

MINIMUM RENTAL PERIOD. The standard minimum rental period is four rental days (4 nights). Rentals of less than 7 days within the month of July are very limited. It is recommended that requests for rentals less than 7 days during this period be made after May 1, 2012.

TRANSFERS. Transfers shall be provided free of charge on days of rental pick up and drop off only between the rental depot and either Anchorage International Airport, Fairbanks International Airport, Skagway Airport, Anchorage, Fairbanks or Skagway area hotels. Transfers will also be provided free of charge on days of pick up and drop off only between the Seattle rental depot and Seattle-Tacoma International.
