



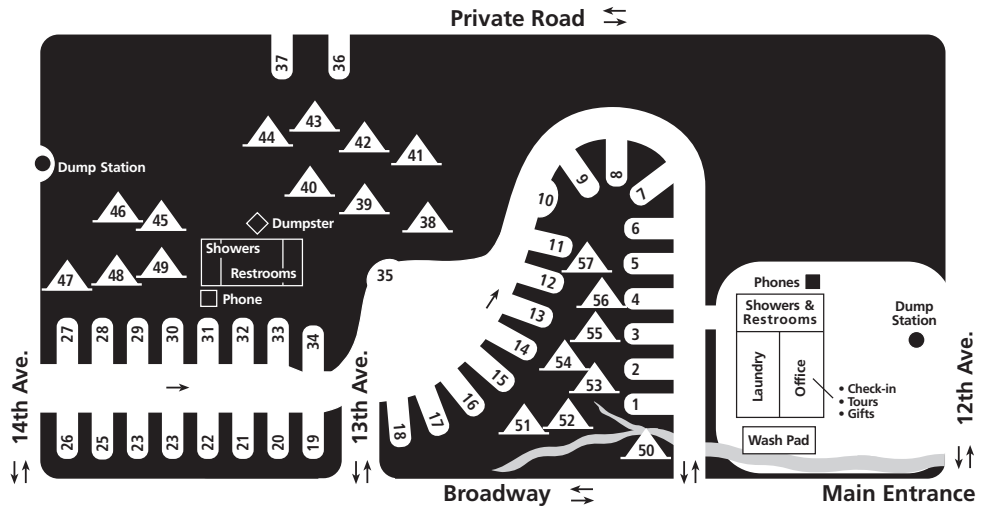

**CAMPGROUND RULES:**

Please do not wash vehicles in the park sites. We have an RV/car wash available for a nominal fee.

Wastewater may be disposed of in dump station only.

Speed limit: 5 mph. Follow all road signs.

Children must be under adult supervision. Parents be aware that trains will be moving on the railroad tracks during the day.

Pets may not be tied up outside and must be on a leash during walks. A walk area is provided for your convenience.

Discharge of fireworks and firearms is prohibited.

**LIARVILLE GOLD RUSH TRAIL CAMP & SALMON BAKE**

At the foot of the White Pass, nestled beside a waterfall, discover Liarsville Gold Rush Trail Camp & Salmon Bake. A cast of sourdoughs and dance hall girls will entertain you with a hilarious melodrama and a poem by the “Bard of the North,” Robert Service, and teach you the art of gold panning! Then, you will be set free in the Liarsville gold fields, where you are guaranteed to find that precious metal that drove men and women wild with gold fever!

Head for the barbecue for a freshly grilled filet of wild Alaskan salmon along with baked chicken, and a variety of side dishes. After lunch, wander over to camp and enjoy the waterfall, authentic exhibits of Liarsville, dance hall girls or the camp’s lovable mascot Denali, an Alaskan malemute.

**FJORD EXPRESS TO JUNEAU**

A fast ferry service from Skagway to Juneau that includes whale watching on every trip! Depart Skagway on the MV Fjordland, a 65-foot fast hulled catamaran. After a short stop in Haines head south through Lynn Canal, the continent’s longest and deepest glacial fjord.

You’ll sail in the shadow of the Coast Range with views of hanging glaciers and historic Eldred Rock lighthouse. Wildlife abounds here. Watch bald eagles, harbor seals, porpoise, orcas and humpback whales. Stop at a rookery where Stellar sea lions gather in the summer months to breed and pup.

Includes bus transfer to Mendenhall Glacier and downtown Juneau with free time for lunch, sightseeing and shopping.

**WHITE PASS & YUKON ROUTE RAILROAD**

“Scenic Railway of the World.” Built in 1898 during the Klondike Gold Rush, this narrow gauge railroad is an International Historic Civil Engineering Landmark.

The **Summit Excursion** is our most popular trip. Your train climbs from tidewater Skagway to the summit of White Pass, nearly 3000 feet in just 20 miles.

Book the **Fraser Meadows Steam Excursion** and travel with one of our steam locomotives six miles beyond the White Pass Summit to Fraser Meadows. Against all odds, the iron trail was carved through some of the North’s most rugged terrain with steep grades and cliff-hanging turns.
